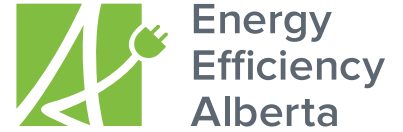


# HOME IMPROVEMENT REBATE PROGRAM



## WHAT IS IT?

The more energy efficiency your home-improvement project creates, the more money you'll get back in rebates. That's the promise of our Home Improvement Rebate Program. You can receive rebates of up to \$3,500 on eligible home improvement products. You'll work with a participating contractor to complete a home improvement project and receive your rebate.

## ELIGIBLE PRODUCTS

- Insulation for attics, basements and above-grade walls – rebates of up to \$3,500 are available for insulation projects
- Tankless hot water heaters (ENERGY STAR® certified) – rebates of up to \$1,000 are available for tankless hot water heaters
- Triple glaze (low-e, argon) windows – rebates of up to \$1,500 are available for qualifying window replacement projects

You're eligible for a rebate in each product category, so each homeowner could qualify for up to \$6,000 in rebates.

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

- Start by finding a participating insulation, window or tankless hot water heater contractor using our participating Contractors Database at [www.energycanada.ca/home-improvement](http://www.energycanada.ca/home-improvement)
- Once you've selected a contractor, they will explain your options in more detail and help you determine the energy savings and subsequent incentive amount available
- After you've given them the go ahead, your contractor will complete your installation and submit the required information to Energy Efficiency Alberta
- Once your contractor submits the application and you verify the completion of the work, you will receive a rebate cheque directly

## WHO IS CONSIDERED A PARTICIPATING CONTRACTOR?

Contractors listed on our website have proven that they:

- Are fully licensed – a legally registered business in the province
- Have \$2 million in liability insurance and Worker Safety insurance
- Are registered with Workers Compensation Board (WCB)
- Have or will participate in future training as it becomes available to maintain their status in the energy efficiency network
- Possess a GST number – to confirm their business is in operation and is registered

For the Home Improvement Rebate, you will work with a participating contractor that is independent from Energy Efficiency Alberta. We always recommend that you investigate contractors for yourself and seek up to three quotes before starting the home improvement process.

## KEY BENEFITS

**Insulation upgrades increase your home's comfort, reduce your energy expenses, and increase your home's value. Best of all there's typically no maintenance.**

**Window upgrades increase home value, increase air-tightness, reduce energy loss, and reduce noise.**

**Tankless hot water systems take up less space, waste less energy and may even provide hot water faster than conventional systems.**



## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

All Albertans can participate in this program using one of the nearly 900 participating contractors.
