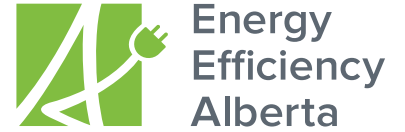


# ONLINE REBATES PROGRAM



## WHAT IS IT?

If you're looking to upgrade your outdated refrigerator or clothes washer, the Online Rebates Program will help make energy efficient options more affordable. The rebates also help you upgrade to a smart thermostat. You're able to apply for a rebate on eligible products through the online application.

## ELIGIBLE PRODUCTS

- **Refrigerators** (CEE Tier 3 and 2) – eligible models are between 15 and 30% more efficient than the federal minimum efficiency standard and between 5 and 10% more efficient than the ENERGY STAR® standard.
- **Clothes washer** (CEE Tier 3) – eligible clothes washers are the most efficient on the market, providing the greatest energy and water savings.
- **Smart thermostats** (Honeywell, Ecobee, Nest, Emerson, Lennox, Tekmar) – adjust the temperature of your home to meet your changing needs over the course of your days and weeks.

- Purchase any eligible, energy-efficient refrigerator, clothes washer or smart thermostat online or in-store

- We'll review the details and once approved you will receive a rebate cheque in six to eight weeks
